

SCORETABLE CODE OF CONDUCT

When on the score table, scorers should follow and obey the rules as set out in the VBSA (Victorian Basketball Scorers Association) code of conduct:

- Scorers should arrive at the venue at least 20 minutes prior to the commencement of the game and should not have any commitments until the score sheet has been signed off at the end of the game. All equipment should be checked before warming up commences (or as soon as possible)
- It is advisable for all scorers to carry their own set of coloured pens or a multi coloured pen
- Food and drink must not be on the score table
- Scorers are NOT TO LEAVE the score table at half time or full time until the score sheet (computer) has been signed off and everything is completed. The score table shall remain supervised during all intervals
- NO MOBILES OR PAGERS are to be left on the score table.
- Scorers must NOT BARRACK from the score table and must not offer any comments to Referees who are officiating or show reaction to the game situation.
- Scorers will conduct themselves in a professional manner and will not become involved with the behaviour of others. All communications with other participants shall be in a courteous manner.

NOTE: The code of conduct applies to ANYONE sitting on the Score table
